Contrastingly, the documentary genre too never failed to impress me with its life mirroring approach and raw narrative. It's interesting to see some of the historically notable works have been created occasionally as a result of some unusual amalgamation of entirely different genres. Docudrama, Docufiction, Docuhorror etc..were examples of such amalgamations. One Such pioneering work is The Legend of Boggy Creek 1972 by Charles B.Pierce. The film is a horror docudrama which has brought in an entirely innovative execution for a monster feature narrative. Personally, I had a great experience watching this film and the film has given me a new kind of outlook towards the horror film genre. It's purely a kind of magic that Pierce has produced with this flick as it gives the viewer a sense of literary horror along with a documentarized experience. What's more bizzare is that the fact the people in the movie seem so real [most of them are locals/non actors], it comfortably makes the monster curve so appealing and relatable in the same grammar.

The Legend of Boggy Creek

The 2007 found footage film Rec is another prime example which has set some remarkable standards in terms of horror film genre and found footage films. There's never been such an original attempt in horror film making that is as effective as Rec. The flow of the film is highly intriguing and the extremely tense atmosphere it has created with the close to life characters has made Rec a completely unique and thrilling experience. I consider both the Legend of Boggy creek and Rec as driving force of this project. Though this project, has nothing to do with the horror themes, the soul and skeleton of this work is hugely inspired from these two works. Other than these, films like District 9, Trollhunter, Millineum Actress have directly or indirectly inspired some of the themes and narratives of this film.

In the world of animation and film making, the shoes of Karel zeman and Ray Harryhausen can never be replaced. Considering their times and the kind of work they have produced, they both stand as unique visionaries and their legend can never be parelleled. Karel Zeman is unlike any visionary in the annals of cinema history. The Only person that came close to his works is Georges Melies atleast in my vision. Because of his commmand over a huge crews, with an artistic approach he has created some of the stupendous works that has brought the best of stop motion, illustration, live action, and hand drawn animation altogether. He had an wonderful visualisation and careful planning such that he was never afraid of mixing the entirely different mediums. Matching the mediums with a common asthetic and maintaining the tone for the entire feature length is something that you can find only in a Karl Zeman films.

The results are some of the iconic works that would definitely give Melies the run for the money. His approach towards planning out the shots with different animation mediums has highly impressed me and I have tried some of the little things I have learned from his movies in this project. What Harryhausen has taught me is a set of whole new other lessons that is quite different from Zeman.

Unlike Zeman, Harryhausen hasn't made complete features but has made a world of his own in puppet design and animation. The way Harryhausen's brings out the best out of his puppets that he personally builds and the kind of magic they create along with the live action footages is something that is definitely one witchcraft of a work. His every single character is a masterful work of precison as well as blissful treat to the eyes. It's mindblowing to hear that he participates in the live action shooting with a marker in his hands, which he would ultimately replace with an animated puppet sequence. Moreover the range of factors such as the direction of light, the camera axis, the actions of the characters that he refines for the final shot is just extraordinary to imagine. Harryhausen approach has taught a lot in importace of basic photographic and animation skills in pulling out a decent character implant into a footage.
























































#### **MIXED MEDIA ANIMATION**
