Overview. Europeans first came in contact with live elephants in 327 BC, when Alexander the Great descended into India from the Hindu Kush, but Alexander was quick to adopt them.

- The surviving elephants were successfully used in the battle of Trebia, where they panicked the Roman cavalry and Gallic allies.


Elephant Range Map











Elephants in the Africa

Today there are an estimated 4,50,000 - 7,00,000 elephants












Elephants Slaughtered in Africa


- Most of the Elephant are killed in Africa only for Ivory.

- *They are divided into central and eastern or rajput bhils
- *They speak Bhili, which is an Indo aryan language.

2. Munda-Jharkhand, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, W-Bengal and Odisha.

- * They speak Mundari, which is an Austro-Asiatic Language.
- *They were Hunters before now they started agriculture.

3. Santhals (Largest tribe in India)-W-bengal, Orissa, Jharkhand, Bihar

- *They speak Santhali, Which is an Austro-Asiatic language.
- *They are engaged in Hunting and fishing and cultivation for they livelihood.

4. Gonda-MP, AP, TGA, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh.

- *They speak Gondi language which is related to Telugu and other dravidian language,north part of gonda speak local hindi.

8.Garos(second largest in India)-North-East States#

- The youngest daughter inherits the property from her mother. Son leaves their parents house at puberty, and are trained in the village, after getting married, the man lives in his wife's house.
- Mostly these people follow christianity, But Rural people follow Animist religion known as Songsarek and its practices.

(According to one oral tradition, the Garos first immigrated to Garo Hills from Tibet (referred to as Tibotgre) around 400 BC under the leadership of Jappa Jalimpa, crossing the Brahmaputra River and tentatively settling in the river valley. The Garos finally settled down in Garo Hills (East-West Garo Hills), finding providence and security in this uncharted territory and claiming it their own. Records of the tribe by invading Mughal armies and by British observers in what is now Bangladesh wrote of the brutality of the people.)

She became a special friend of 49-yr old Shanti- A Temple elephant in tamil nadu.






- Toomai(Sabu) a young boy growing up in India, who wants to b a hunter.

- One fine day sabu finds a large herd of elephants so he informs Petersen abt then and captures the herd of elephants, so people hail him as "Toomai of the Elephants".
























