

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1. Abstract

We surround ourselves with different products everyday. The choice of the product vary from person to person. This study focuses on documenting those products for different users of same age group do the analysis of the same and shows how these kind of documentation can be helpful in the field of design like designing for the future, concept design or for generating a user persona.

2. Introduction

The moment we wake up to the moment we go to sleep our life is divided in different phases. We can divide these phases into mainly two categories,

A professional life: Where we have to behave in a certain way, we have to use certain kind of products which are provided to us and life which helps us to meet our needs.

A Personal life: This is the phase in a day where it is more about a person's own choices and wishes. Here a person is free to use whatever product he or she wants to use, there is no boundary here. It may include maintaining hygiene, taking care of health, going to a gym, evening leisure time, learning a new hobby, playing with pets, reading books or may be going on a hike on a weekend.

In both phases we use various kind of products and these products tells a story about us when they come together. With the evolution of a mankind rate of evolution of products also changes. Even though the function of the product remains the same; form, aesthetic look, specification and its property vary. (For example, a main function of soap is to keep clean our body but the number of soap which are available in markets vary from shapes, smell, ingredients and price perspective.) Each person has their own philosophy of living life, culture, adaption of technology, aesthetic sense, hobbies, interest, inspiration, need, wants and value of beliefs guide a person to choice certain kind of products.

In the field of archeology, they study the human history, society and culture based on their objects, tools, artifacts, clothes and other artifacts. Which indicates how product gives the sense of someone's life. This Design research aims on creating an visual directory of different products so that it

can be helpful in future to study how mankind as well as different products are evolving . The Design Research Seminar topic "How we live through products we use" mainly revolve around a documentation of these products for particular users (age group 20 to 28, college going youngsters and recent graduates), observation of that documentation and to connect the dots between products and people.

3. Methodology

To carryout documentation of products, a diverse users were selected between age group of 20 to 28 years. All these users are college going youngsters with strong hobbies which they might pursue in a future as a main career. User group here includes arts students, design students, engineering students, photographer, fashion model etc.

The idea was to approach these people and ask them about product they use the most on daily bases. These products were grouped in different categories such as grooming, diet, makeup essentials, electronics items and gadgets, body accessories, stationary, books, hobby items, profession items, sport items, clothing and footwear. Since study was done with the people of Mumbai and Gujarat, certain quota was avoided such as food items since it remains almost the same in each case. If person was using certain food and beverage items which was not common in most the cases or items which was a part of their hobby, were included to show their lifestyle. Also, Users were asked to describe their day and weekends.

A list of the products were prepared along with its brand and then these products were photographed based on its category. These photos were further photo-shopped for better presentation. A documentation was done in a way that first page shows all the products a person was using. Next page contains written inventory of products, a synopsis of person's daily life what he or she likes the most, person's picture, name, age and profession(s). Before documenting products verbal consent was given regarding keep their identity secret. So picture of the user in the report are edited and names are changed.

Based on theses documentations an observational analysis was done and conclusion was made.

A person can come to conclusion about user's lifestyle, user's sex and age, their daily routine and profession and can critically comment about personality of the user by only observing documented products. This documentation is useful to connect the dots between various users of particular region and a trend can be mapped, how the environment, interest and hobby can affect the selection of the products. 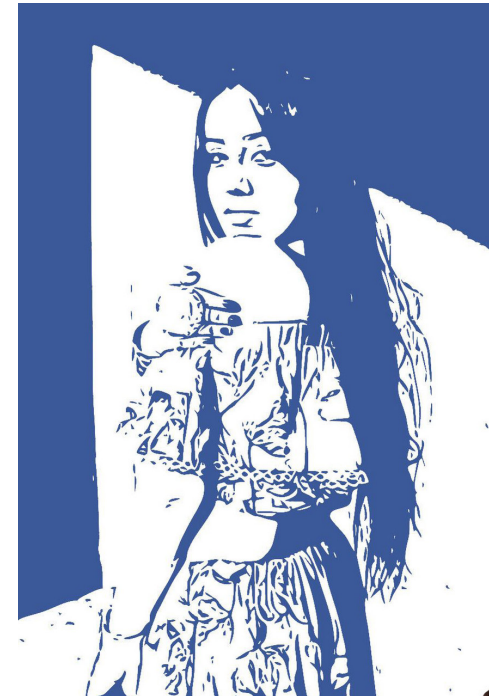

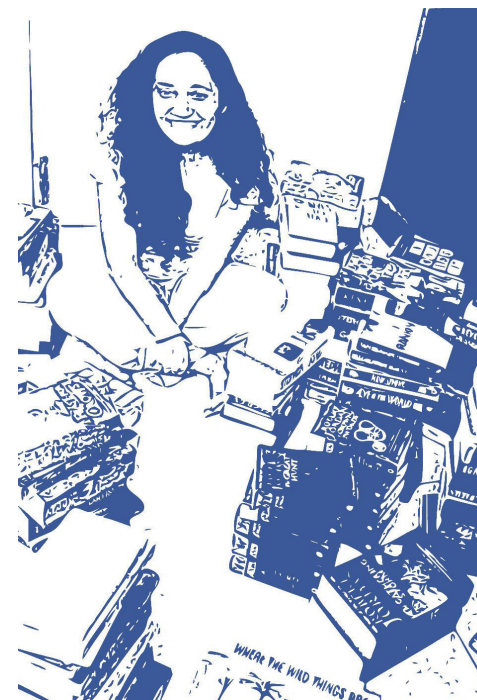
