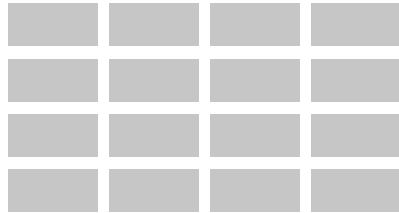

- Searched on the internet but could not completely understand the meaning of the word.

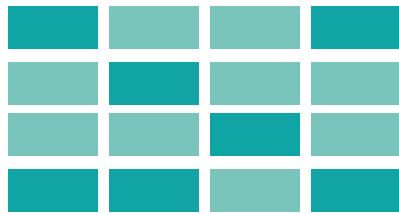

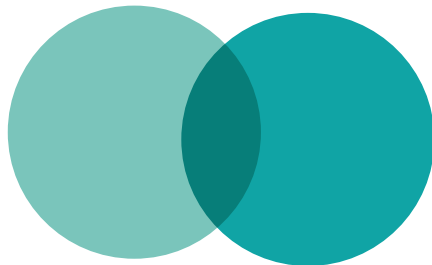

An ampersand is a logogram "&" representing the conjunction word "and". This symbol originated as a ligature of the letters et, Latin for "and".

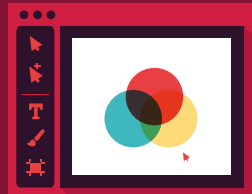

Boustrophedon

Boustrophedon is a kind of bi-directional text, mostly seen in ancient manuscripts and other inscriptions. Every other line of writing is flipped or reversed, with reversed letters. Rather than going left-to-right as in modern English, or right-to-left as in Arabic and Hebrew, alternate lines in boustrophedon must be read in opposite directions.

Bracketed Serif

A serif is the little extra stroke found at the end of main vertical and horizontal strokes of some letterforms. Bracketed serifs provide a curved transition or a wedge-like connection between the serif and the main strokes.

Callout Box

It is a special text box with or without a small "tail" that can be pointed to different locations on a document. It is also used to describe a short piece of text set in larger type than the rest of the page and intended to attract attention.

Contrast (Typography)

The degree of contrast or variation between the thick and thin strokes of a given letter. Modern serif typefaces such as Bodoni have very high contrast, old style serif typefaces such as Garamond have low contrast.

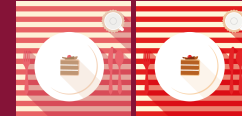

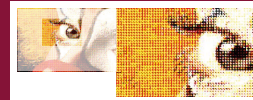

Dithering

Dithering is the process of juxtaposing pixels of two colors to create the illusion that a third color is present. By combining two different colour pixels in complex patterns it can create the illusion of another colour value.



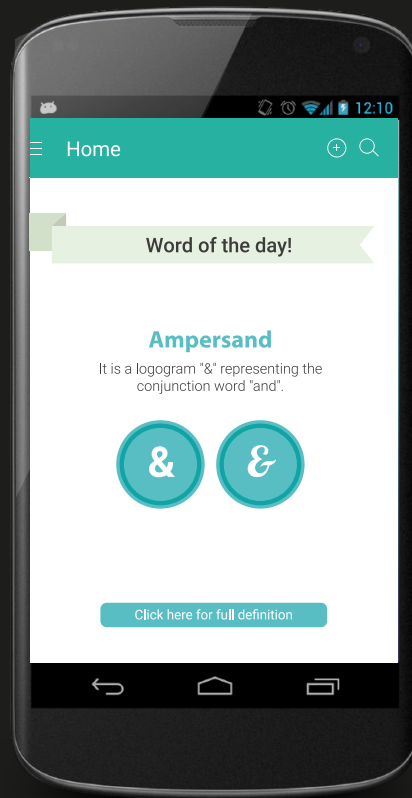
