

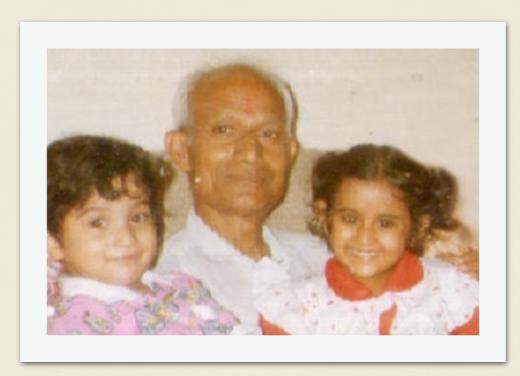

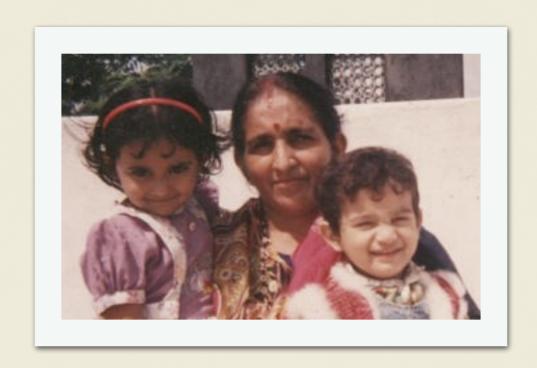
Why this project?

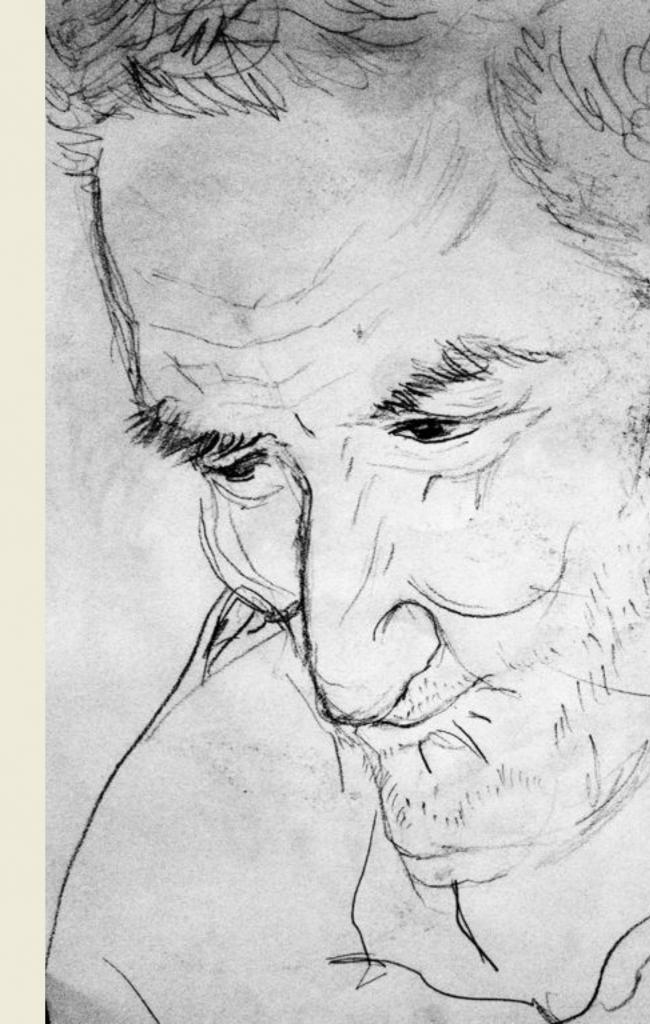
### **Key points**

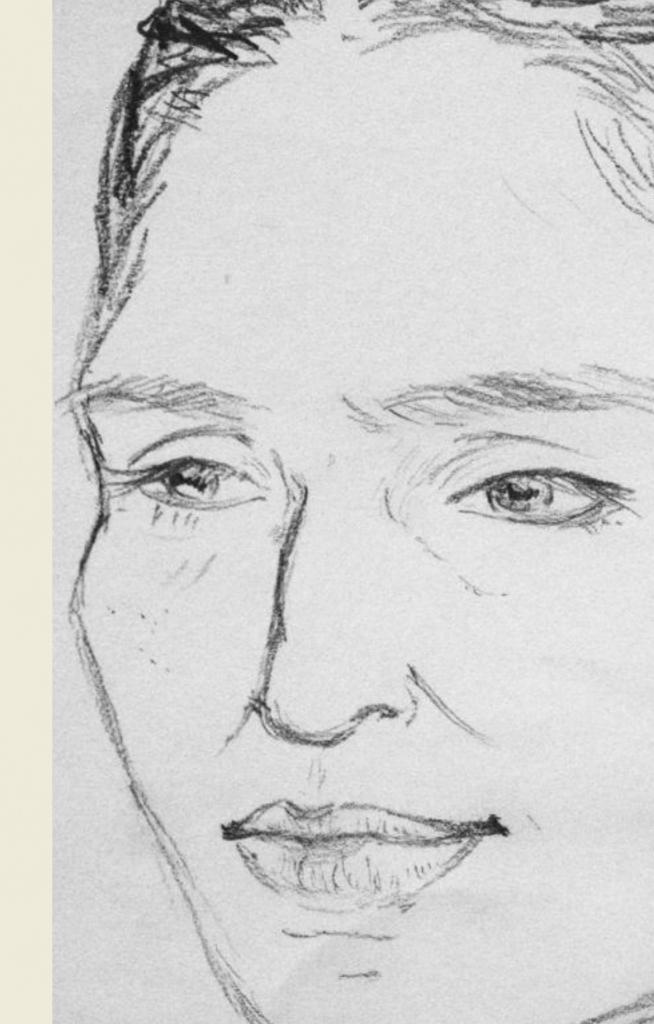

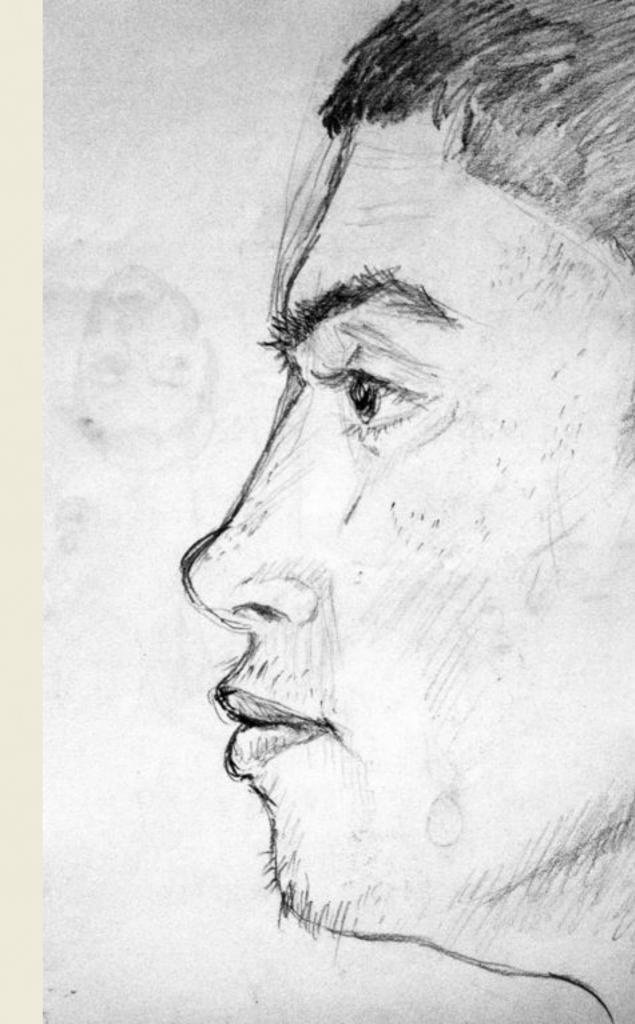
