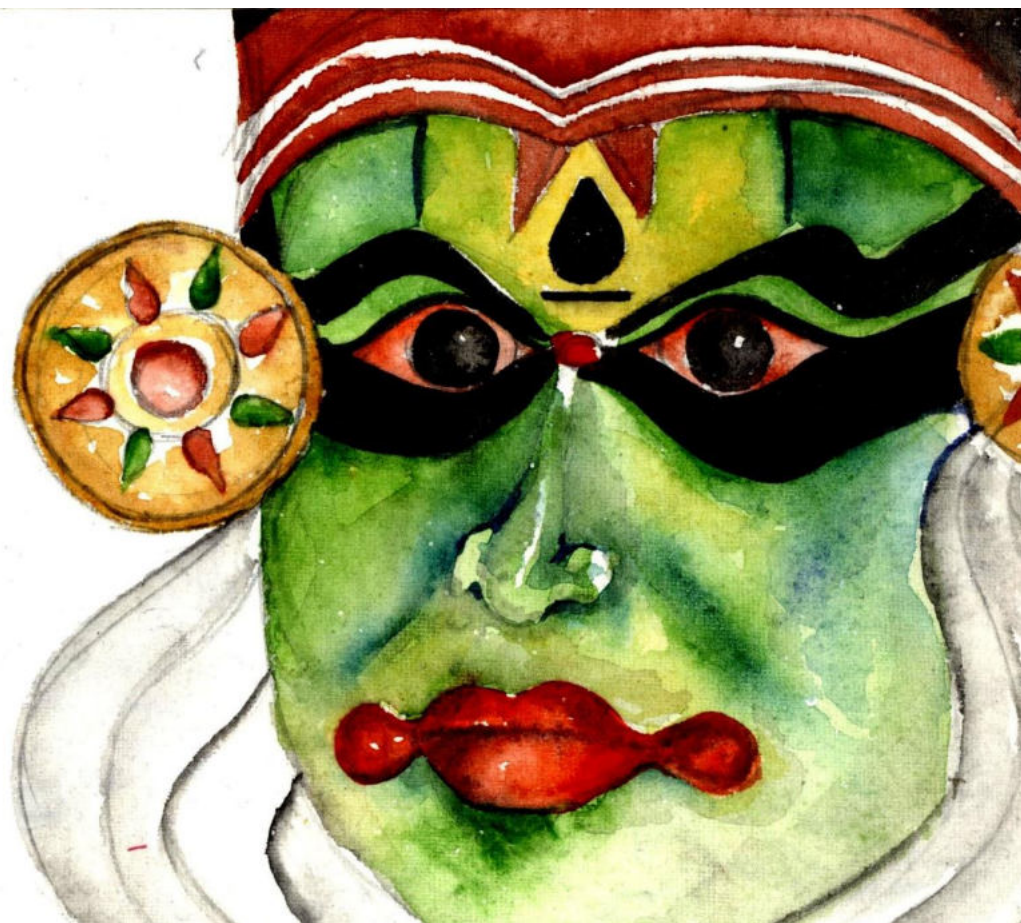
















## Conclusion
