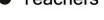

LOW VISION

Low vision is defined in a person as, who has impairment of visual functioning even after treatment and/or standard refractive correction, and has a visual acuity of less than 6/18 to light perception

Skills to be assessd and training givenattention, reach, maintain gaze tracking, shift gaze, change fixation, follow path, identify objects, imitation, abstract figures,, understanding details

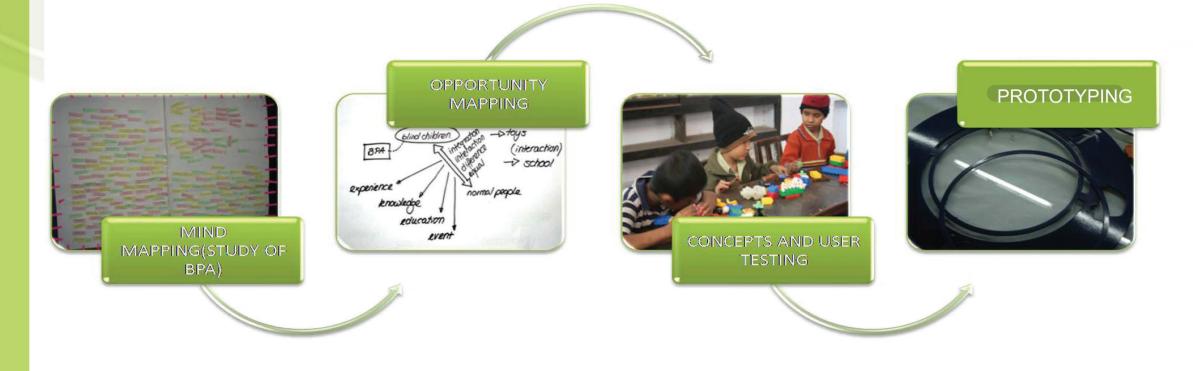

wood, ply,acrylic,bulb,wiring ,regulator(fan),glue

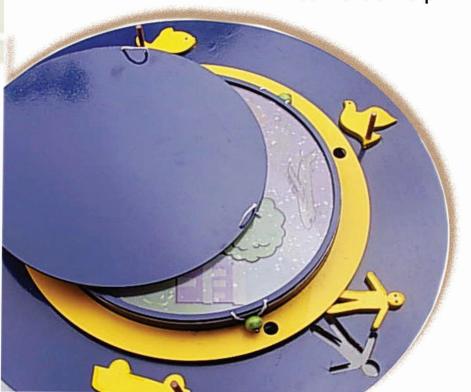
PARTS:

Light regulator which helps increase and decrease contrast
Circular moveable disc
Cut outs on the circular disc which can be matched
Center acrylic board with a story setting to facilitate storytelling
Lid to cover the center to focus on the cut outs.

BENEFITS:

-Low vision assesment and trainingskills like tracking ,reach, following path,maintain gaze , fixation,shift gaze,identifying objects can be assessed and trained

-The teachers who do not have much training in low vision training can asses the level of vision in the children, the amount of contrast required and can also help in training their vision
